Dear Volunteer:

Thanks for volunteering to help out with security at the Korean Culture Camp. Your willingness to help out in this way is very much appreciated. Here is a brief description of your work for the camp.

Job Description:

- ❑ Walk the perimeter of the camp and inside of the school building to observe the coming and going of campers and adults.
- ❑ Report any suspicious activity to the front desk.
- ❑ Be available to perform any necessary set-ups- i.e. setting up risers for pictures.
- ❑ Assure that only campers and volunteers are in the building. Anyone without a button or camp shirt needs to be approached and questioned.
- ❑ Help to assure that only small groups of children use the bathroom at any given time. This will help avoid larger groups of kids hassling a child in the bathroom.
- ❑ Meet at the front desk 15 minutes early on the day you volunteer for a brief orientation meeting with the security area coordinator.
